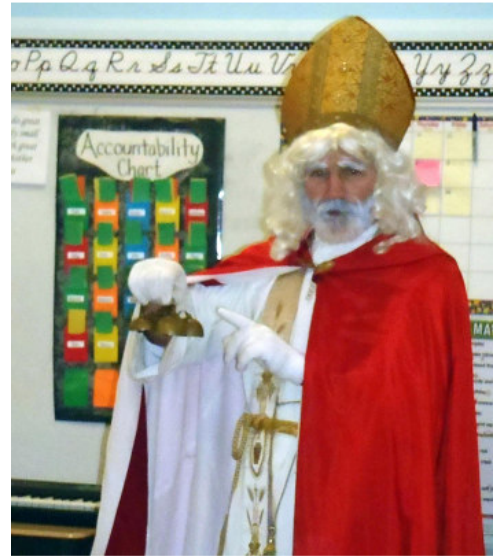


The Saint Who Came to Visit!

Information Regarding School Closures

Now that wintry cold weather is upon us, it's time to prepare for the possibility of delayed openings or school closures due to snow or icy conditions. Please check page 24 of the Parent/Teacher Handbook regarding closures. **Our school follows the decision of the Gervais School District #1 regarding closures and delays.**

Following are radio and television stations – and a website that will carry the delay/closure information. You may also call the Gervais School District at 503-792-3803 (press 1 at the prompt). Please remember that **you will not be contacted** if the Gervais School District decides on a closure or delay. You must check one of the listed radio or television stations, the website, or the Gervais school district to find that information.

Although we have an 'Emergency Contact List' in the back of the Parent/Student Directory, that contact list is used ONLY when GSD is not in session and our school is (this rarely happens) or if there is a problem specific to our school (no water, no electricity, no heat, etc.).
