FACTS TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM: It is time to begin thinking about next year's tuition costs! This year all applications for tuition assistance are to be completed online. The webpage address is www.factstuitionaid.com. Applications are due by March 30, 2010. Any family who would like to receive tuition assistance from the school must first apply through the FACTS Tuition Assistance Program.
